



Charm Tablemat

Charm Tablemat

Finished size: approximately 17" x 17"

This small tablemat is made from a purchased "Charm Square" or 5" x 5" scrap squares of fabric found in your stash. The block is so easy...you might just want to make a larger quilt from these strip pieced blocks.

CUTTING

From 16 **light** charm squares, cut:

3 strips, 1-1/8" x 5"

From 16 **dark** charm squares, cut:

4 strips, 1-1/8" x 5"

SEWING THE QUILT

1. To make one block - Sew 4 dark strips alternated with 3 light strips. Press the seam allowances toward the dark strips. Make 16 blocks.
2. **THIS IS IMPORTANT...** Measure the average size of your blocks. They should measure between 4-3/4" and 4-7/8". Trim - so that the blocks are square.
3. Sew the blocks into 4 rows, rotating the blocks to run horizontally and vertically.
4. Layer with batting and backing.
5. Quilt as desired.
6. Bind with 1-1/2" straight strips.
